Internal Quality Assurance Cell 12th External Meeting - Minutes of the Meeting

12th IQAC External Meeting was convened on Saturday, the 28th June, 2025 at 1.00 PM at SICM Campus, in A V Room. The Proceedings of the previous meeting were read along with the Action Taken Report. Upon the approval sought by the members further matters were discussed in the order of agenda.

Resolutions -

1. Confirmation of Previous Meeting Proceedings

The proceedings and Action Taken Report (ATR) of the 11th IQAC Meeting were read and unanimously approved by all members present.

2. New Programs Implementation – AY 2024-25

IQAC Coordinator **Assoc. Prof. Bhuvaneshwari R S** presented updates on the newly introduced academic programs:

- B. Com in Business Data Analytics (BDA)
- Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA)

Both programs commenced successfully at the **newly established extended campus**, with experienced aculty heads leading each stream.

3. Curriculum Enrichment/ MOOC courses and Certification Initiatives

- A total of **14 certificate courses** were offered to students. The coordinator shared detailed insights from the **feedback analysis** conducted post-completion.
- Additionally, a report on MOOC-based training via IIT Mumbai's Spoken Tutorial platform was presented, highlighting the participation of over 850 students.

4. Academic and Co-curricular Enrichment

- Updates were shared on industrial visits arranged across departments to bridge theory and industry practices.
- A summary of the Erudite National Conference 2025 was presented, showcasing multidisciplinary academic engagement.
- Student conference from IKS information was also shared.

5. IQAC Activity Updates for 2024-25

The following initiatives were reported under IQAC quality measures:

- AQAR Submission for AY 2023–24 completed
- ISO Certification process successfully completed
- Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) underway
- Stakeholder Feedback from students, faculty, alumni, and employers was collected and analysed for improvement insights

6. Academic Activity Updates

- Several Curriculum Enrichment Sessions and expert lectures were conducted.
- Final Year Viva Voce for B. Com and BBA students was conducted in May 2025 to assess
 internship outcomes and presentation skills. Faculty feedback indicated improved student
 articulation and industry readiness.

7. Suggestions by Alumni Representatives -

The alumni representatives present in the meeting shared valuable suggestions to further strengthen academic and employability initiatives:

• Integration of AI Tools

Recommended embedding **AI tools and technologies** into curriculum delivery to align students with the evolving digital landscape.

• Techno-functional Curriculum for BBA

Alumni emphasized domain-specific knowledge through:

- o SQL
- System Interface
- Supply Chain

 Certified courses tailored for product-based companies (e.g., modelled on NRTI – Vadodara approach)

• Ethical and Critical Thinking

Suggested enhancing **ethical decision-making** and **critical reasoning** in class discussions and assessments.

Fostering Innovation

Encouraged practices that promote **innovative thinking**, such as idea generation, creative assignments, and reading-based learning.

Placement Preparedness

Recommended focused training sessions on:

- Understanding Job Descriptions (JDs)
- o Industry-specific terminology
- o Process awareness leading to offer letter acquisition

8. Additional Alumni Input:

Another alumni member and industry expert, Mr. Vinay M H, shared valuable insights via email regarding the suggestions about the new courses on Introducing Generative AI Awareness and Skill Training. His suggestions have been duly noted and the email has been enclosed with the meeting records for further review and consideration during curriculum planning.



I truly appreciate the efforts of **Seshadripuram Institute of Commerce and Management (SICM)** in actively implementing past IQAC recommendations — including the **Power BI Certification** and **Digital Marketing Internship**, which are highly relevant to today's industry demands.

Suggestion for upcoming IQAC Meeting: Introducing Generative AI Awareness and Skill Training

As an industry representative, I strongly recommend introducing **awareness and skill-based training in Generative AI tools** like **Google Gemini**, **ChatGPT**, and other AI assistants. These technologies are no longer niche — they are quickly becoming foundational across domains like finance, marketing, operations, HR, and even content creation.

Why Generative Al Skills Are Crucial for Students:

- According to TeamLease Digital's report (2024), nearly 69% of companies in India are actively seeking
 candidates with AI/ML exposure, particularly in prompt engineering and AI tool fluency.
- NASSCOM's Talent Report 2024 notes that job applicants with GenAl knowledge have a 30–40% higher chance of selection, especially in data-centric and client-facing roles.
- Entry-level roles now increasingly test for basic Al literacy (e.g., writing prompts, generating reports, or summarizing data using tools like ChatGPT).

With the job market rapidly evolving, it is essential that our students are **not just academically sound but also industry-ready**.

I kindly request the council to consider sharing the following recommended free resources with students, enabling them to upskill in the area of Generative AI.

Additionally, I suggest that faculty members may consider assigning a task where students can submit a brief presentation or report on:

- · The new GenAl skill or tool they have learned, and
- Its practical application in their academic journey (e.g., preparing Viva reports, project summaries, content generation, etc.)

This not only fosters active learning but also encourages students to explore how these emerging technologies can enhance their productivity and academic output in meaningful ways.
